**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Increases to tuition are recommended by the administration following an analysis of the university's inflationary pressures, and their impact on maintaining excellence in teaching and learning, student advising and support services and programs, and core university operations. The proposed increases were considered in light of prior years' benchmarking of tuition rates of comparable postsecondary educational institutions, including the U15 Group of Canadian Research Universities – a collective of some of Canada's most research-intensive universities – and publicly-funded universities that are similarly ranked.

A consultative, institution-wide budget consultation process was conducted involving elected student leaders, Vancouver and Okanagan senates, senior staff, academic heads and directors, associate deans, and deans, to review the experience of FY2020/21, the impacts of the pandemic, highlights of expenditures approved and initiatives supported, the context of budget planning for FY2021/22 with key priorities. It was emphasized that the priority for FY2021/22 continues to be UBC's COVID-19 response: supporting the long-term health and wellbeing of students, faculty, and staff above all other considerations.

In addition to the immediate pandemic response, UBC remains steadfast in its key strategic priorities, including:

- Making additional investments in students, faculty, and staff to better support and innovate remote teaching, learning, research, and working;
- Advocating for anti-racism, equity, diversity, and inclusion, and making meaningful progress through thoughtful and deliberate actions;
- Supporting the implementation of the Indigenous Strategic Plan;
- Implementing the President's Academic Excellence Initiative;
- Fulfilling the recommendations of the Climate Emergency Task Force, and the Climate Action Plan;
- Supporting the Faculties' initiatives to elevate UBC's teaching, learning, and research capabilities through Faculty resources and the Academic Excellence Funds; and
- Continuing to pursue operational excellence.

### **Tuition for Domestic Undergraduate and Graduate Students**

A 2% increase in domestic tuition is proposed for all domestic students for 2021/22, effective May 1, 2021, for programs listed in Schedule A. This proposed increase would be applied for both campuses.

Current provincial government policy has limited domestic tuition and all mandatory fee increases for 2021/22 to 2% for all programs, including differentiated, post-baccalaureate and professional graduate programs. The Tuition Limit Policy has been in place since 2005.

### **Tuition for International Undergraduate and Graduate Students**

The administration is recommending that, effective May 1, 2021, international tuition be increased for 2021/22 as follows:

- A 2% increase in tuition for new and continuing international graduate students in programs with standard rates;
- A 4% increase in tuition for new incoming international undergraduate students and graduate students in programs with specialized rates, as set out in Schedule A;
- A 2% increase in tuition for continuing international undergraduate students and graduate students in programs with specialized rates, who entered their degree programs prior to May 1, 2021, as set out in Schedule A; and
- A 4% increase in international per credit tuition for unclassified, qualifying, visiting, access studies, and auditing students.

### **Incremental Tuition Allocation**

It is further recommended that any incremental tuition related to the proposed rate increases for FY21/22, for undergraduates, if approved by the Board, be directed towards COVID-19 impacted key student priorities (and hence not allocated to the Faculties, Academic Excellence Funds, or central contingencies) on a one-time without precedent basis. The projected one-time amount (\$15.2M for Vancouver and \$2.8M for the Okanagan) will be allocated to areas that have been directly impacted by the pandemic to help students cope with extraordinary circumstances brought about by COVID-19 pandemic.

## Consultation

Under the guidelines of Policy LR4, the Vancouver and Okanagan Provosts and Vice-Presidents, Academic, Vice-President, Students, and Deputy Vice-Chancellor conducted a student consultation regarding the proposed general tuition and fee increases for 2021/2022.

The consultation was conducted over the period of January 25, 2021 and February 26, 2021.

The student consultation process included the following components:

- Meeting with the leadership of the Alma Mater Society (AMS), Graduate Student Society (GSS) on UBC's Vancouver campus, and the Students' Union (SUO) on UBC's Okanagan campus to provide an overview of UBC's budget and process (Budget 101).
- Meeting with the AMS, GSS, SUO leadership to provide visibility and opportunity to provide feedback, into the draft 2021/2022 Tuition consultation content.
- There was significant work done last year to improve and optimize the consultation process and experience for students, this year we employed a similar approach in implementing the consultation website and communications plan.
- Consultation rationale was adjusted to acknowledge and address the COVID-19 context and financial pressures on students, and to focus on student health, wellbeing, and financial supports.
- If tuition increases as proposed for 2021-2022, UBC proposes to allocate all of this year's incremental funding for-credit tuition revenue resulting from the rate increases towards COVID-19 impacted key priorities. This is a one-time allocation to help students cope with the extraordinary circumstance brought about the COVID-19 pandemic. A new question was added to the consultation questionnaire, this year. Specifically, students were asked to rank 4 priority areas in the order they think they should be funded, including: student financial aid to support tuition costs, cost of living (e.g. food, housing, and transportation), delivery of hybrid teaching and student programs and services for hybrid learning. These results will be one source of many used by UBC's administration to determine funding allocations.
- PAIR continues to provide support with data collection and analysis expertise.
- Tuition Consultation website featured:
  - The University's considerations and benchmarking process when determining tuition fees.
  - How tuition fees contribute to ongoing and new investments in the student experience – including investments in the classroom, student services, and student supports.
  - Consultation rationale was adjusted to acknowledge and address the COVID-19 context and financial pressures on students, and to focus on student health, wellbeing, and financial supports.
  - Confidential feedback form, open between January 25, 2021 and February 26, 2021.

A report with the analysis from both quantitative and qualitative feedback opportunities is attached. Individual student comments are also attached verbatim.

# PREFACE



- Student financial aid is considerable and growing rapidly, ensuring access by providing support for an increasing number of students each year. At the same time, debt levels at graduation have remained relatively constant
- The impact of COVID-19 has impacted our community in many ways. In addition to the support provided by both federal and provincial governments, UBC has provided increased supports to students in response to this impact, including financial and online learning support, and health and safety support
- The Administration has recently concluded student consultations on a **4%** tuition increase for all new international students and a **2%** tuition increase for all international continuing students and all new and continuing domestic students. This 2% increase also applies to all mandatory fees.
- 5,883 respondents completed this year's student tuition consultation, an increase of 578 (10.9% increase) over the 2020/21 consultation.

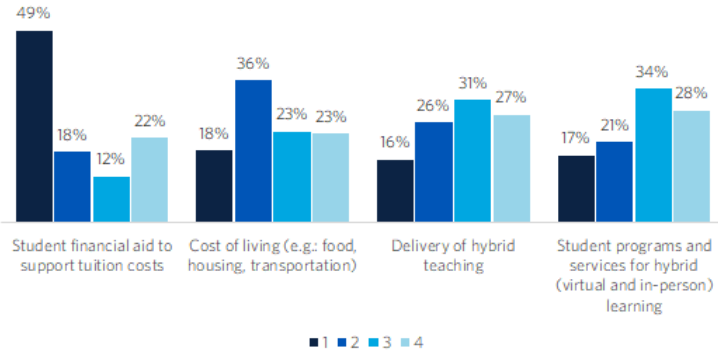


# STUDENT RANKING OF STUDENT DIRECTED PRIORITY AREAS

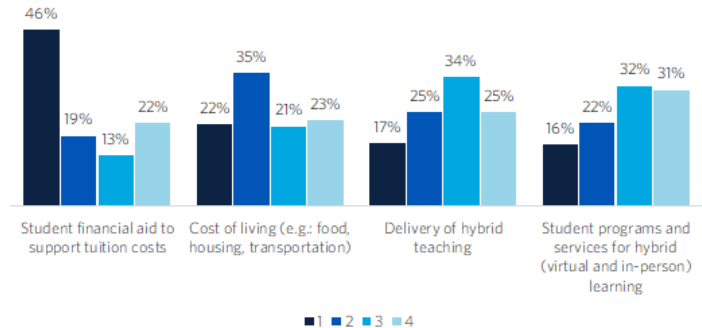

## Vancouver Results (4,524 responses)

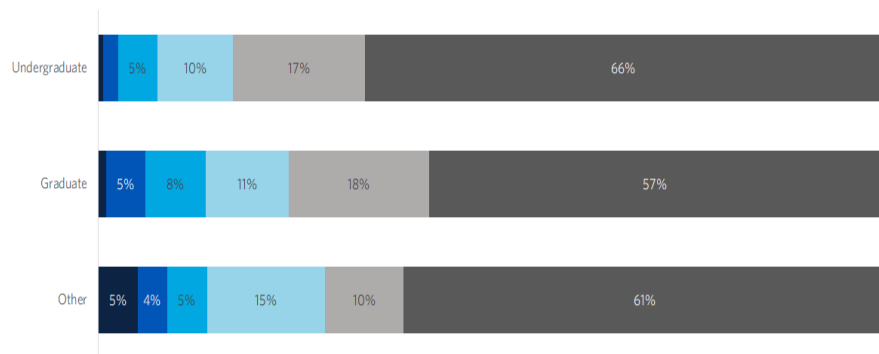




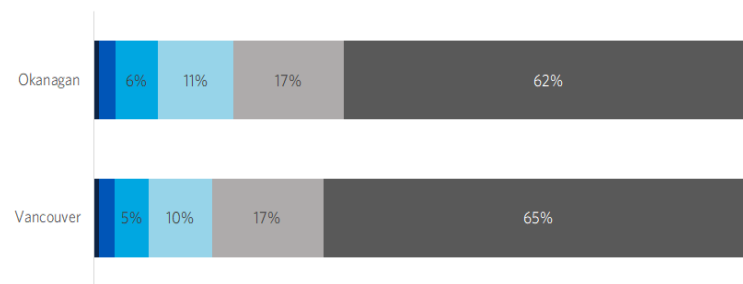
# LEVEL OF AGREEMENT WITH TUITION INCREASE

Q. 2: Please rate your level of agreement with the proposed tuition increase

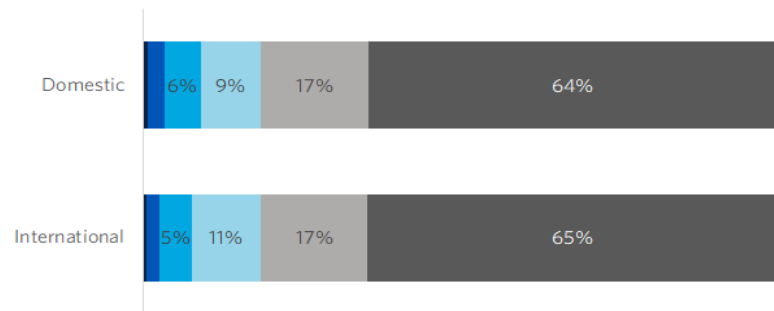

## PROPOSED TUITION RATE INCREASES

- **2%** tuition increase for all new and continuing domestic students. ( An annual tuition increase in the range of appx. \$110 to \$377 for a full time year of studies)
- **4%** tuition increase for all new international students and 2% for all continuing international students ( An annual tuition increase in the range of appx. \$1.5K to \$2.8K for a full time year of studies)
- Proposed tuition increases will contribute additional \$18 million in incremental revenue (0.78% of the operating budget of \$2.3 billion)
- \$18 million will be invested in the following student directed priorities
  - Student Financial Aid : \$8.0 million
  - Cost of living : \$2.4 million
  - Delivery of hybrid learning and student programs and services : \$7.6 million.

#### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This briefing is related to the tuition proposal item being submitted to the Finance Committee for approval at the April 7<sup>th</sup> meeting. The appendix for that item is where you will find Schedule A.

Either a 0% or 2% increase is proposed for various non-instructional fees. Non-instructional fees fall into two categories: tuition-related fees (e.g. Co-op fees) and various other mandatory fees (e.g. Application fees).

Tuition-related fees are effective May 1, 2021 and various mandatory fees are effective September 1, 2021. These apply to both campuses. The recommended increases in non-instructional fees reflect an increase in the cost of delivering services.

#### Schedule B

To reflect an increase in the cost of delivering services, a 2% increase is proposed for the majority of tuition-related and mandatory non-instructional fees.

In addition, with the recommendation of the School of Biomedical Engineering, the Biomedical Engineering annual program fee (currently set at \$795.75 for students in Years 2 through 4) is proposed to not be assessed of students registered in a UBC co-op work term, and the fee assessed of Biomedical Engineering students who repeat a program year (currently set at \$188.50) is proposed to be eliminated. This fee was established to cover some of the costs associated with state-of-the-art lab equipment, maintenance, cell culture supplies, consumables, reagents, instruments, computers, personal protective equipment, and more. The School has re-evaluated the fees necessary to support the program to alleviate financial pressures on students, and determined that the costs of supporting students are sufficiently covered in the existing annual program fee for students in Years 2-4.

#### Schedule C

The President has approved a 2% increase for selected administrative services (non-mandatory) to reflect increases in the cost of delivering services.

Your approval of the attached Schedule C, Cost Recovery Fee items, is requested for the 2021/22 academic year. These fees apply to both the Vancouver and Okanagan campuses. This Schedule was revised in November 2003 to set these items at a cost recovery level and have had increases applied annually ever since. They are presented to the Board for information and not for approval because they are not mandatory fees.

All items have been reviewed. A 2% inflationary increase is proposed for the following administrative services (non-mandatory) to reflect an increase in the cost of delivering services:

- Deferred Examination
- Degree Conversion
- Diploma Certification
- Distance Education and Tech Special Examination
- Duplicate Income Tax Receipt – T2202A
- Faxes
- Parchment Replacement
- Review of Assigned Standing (per course)
- Supplemental Examination
- Transcript
- Document Distribution - Courier

Because these are non-mandatory cost recovery items with a proposed 2% inflationary increase, an extensive consultation was not conducted. The UBC Alma Mater Society (AMS), Graduate Student Society (GSS), and UBC Students' Union Okanagan (UBCSUO) were informed of these recommended changes on January 11, 2021 and were given an opportunity to provide feedback. The increases, if

approved, will be made effective May 1, 2021. Schedule C will be sent to the Board of Governors as an information item.
