IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the Finance Committee recommends that the Board of Governors approve the following, applicable to students on the Vancouver and Okanagan campuses effective May 1, 2023:

- *i.* A 2% increase in tuition for new and continuing domestic undergraduate and graduate students, for the programs specified in Schedule A.
- ii. An increase in tuition for international students as follows:
 - a. a 5% increase in tuition for new incoming international undergraduate students, as set out in Schedule A;
 - b. a 3% increase in tuition for continuing international undergraduate students, who entered their degree programs prior to May 1, 2023, as set out in Schedule A;
 - c. a 2% increase in tuition for new international graduate students in programs with standard rates, as set out in Schedule A;
 - d. a 2% increase in tuition for continuing international graduate students in programs with standard rates, as set out in Schedule A;
 - e. a 5% increase in tuition for new incoming international graduate students in programs with specialized rates, as set out in Schedule A;
 - f. a 3% increase in tuition for international graduate students in programs with specialized rates, who entered their degree programs prior to May 1, 2023, as set out in Schedule A; and,
 - g. a 5% increase in international per credit tuition for unclassified, qualifying, visiting, access studies, and auditing students.
- *iii.* An increase of 2% for Non-Instructional Fees as specified in Schedule B, applicable to students on the Vancouver and Okanagan campuses effective May 1, 2023.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The administration seeks to keep tuition as low as possible while maintaining operations and infrastructure, and while continuing to make meaningful investments to advance the key priorities of the UBC Strategic Plan.

Recommended increases are made after an analysis of inflationary pressures and their impact on maintaining university operations, and prior year's benchmarking against tuition rates and trends of comparable educational institutions, including the U15 Group of Canadian Research Universities – a collective of some of Canada's most research-intensive universities.

UBC remains steadfast in its key strategic priorities, including:

- UBC's continued recovery from the impacts of COVID-19 (applies to all four core areas of the Strategic Plan)
- Equity, diversity, and inclusion with a specific focus on anti-racism (in alignment with People and Places)
- Indigenous engagement, and the implementation of the Indigenous Strategic Plan (in alignment with Local and Global Engagement)
- The President's Academic Excellence Initiative (in alignment with both Research Excellence, Great People, and Transformative Learning)
- Sustainability and Climate Action (applies to all four core areas of the Strategic Plan)

Tuition for Domestic Undergraduate and Graduate Students

A 2% increase in domestic tuition is proposed for all domestic students for 2023-2024, effective May 1, 2023, for programs listed in Schedule A. This proposed increase would be applied for both campuses.

Current provincial government policy has limited domestic tuition and all mandatory fee increases for 2023-2024 to 2% for all programs, including differentiated, post-baccalaureate and professional graduate programs. The Tuition Limit Policy has been in place since 2005.

Tuition for International Undergraduate and Graduate Students

The administration is recommending that, effective May 1, 2023, international tuition be increased for 2023-2024 as follows:

- A 5% increase in tuition for new incoming international undergraduate students, as set out in Schedule A.
- A 3% increase in tuition for continuing international undergraduate students, who entered their degree programs prior to May 1, 2023, as set out in Schedule A;
- A 2% increase in tuition for new international graduate students in programs with standard rates, as set out in Schedule A;
- A 2% increase in tuition for continuing international graduate students in programs with standard rates, as set out in Schedule A;
- A 5% increase in tuition for new incoming international graduate students in programs with specialized rates, as set out in Schedule A;
- A 3% increase in tuition for international graduate students in programs with specialized rates, who entered their degree programs prior to May 1, 2023, as set out in Schedule A; and,
- A 5% increase in international per credit tuition for unclassified, qualifying, visiting, access studies, and auditing students.

Consultation

Under the guidelines of Policy LR4, the Vancouver and Okanagan Provosts and Vice-Presidents Academic, Vice-President Students, and Deputy Vice-Chancellor conducted a student consultation regarding the proposed general tuition and fee increases for 2023-2024.

The consultation was conducted over the period of October 3, 2022 and October 31, 2022. Please refer to the "Tuition Engagement 2023-2024" briefing note also submitted to the Finance Committee for a summary of the consultation process and results.

Tuition and Mandatory Fee Increase Analysis and Rationale

UBC continues to maintain one of the lowest domestic tuition rates amongst BC peers, and international tuition rates commensurate with UBC's Times Higher Education World ranking position within its peer group. Across peers, UBC is the second largest provider of student financial aid as a percentage of tuition revenue.

Student financial aid is considerable and growing rapidly, ensuring access by providing support for an increasing number of students each year. At the same time, debt levels at graduation have remained relatively constant.

For this past year, the Federal and Provincial CPI saw the largest year-over-year increase in nearly 40 years (more than 7%). The Higher Education Price Index, a measure of inflation across US colleges and universities, is predicting a 5.2% increase for this year.

For domestic undergraduate students, a 2% increase results in an annual tuition increase ranging from roughly \$114 to \$392 for a full-time year of studies, with significant financial support available to ensure each student can maintain a moderate standard of living.

For international undergraduate students, a 5% increase for new and a 3% increase for continuing students results in an annual tuition increase ranging from roughly \$1.2K to \$3.9K for a full-time year of studies.

By maintaining the 2% increase for domestic tuition, and a modest increase for international tuition, our base tuition rate upon which future increases will apply will enable the university to cover some inflationary pressures and allow us to continue to invest in the core academic mission of the university, including the student learning experience, as well as recommendations from the Student Affordability Task Force and President's Task Force on Anti-Racism and Inclusive Excellence Report.

A 0% tuition increase would be very difficult to reverse in future years given the Province's cap on domestic tuition. While the University can manage the impact in the immediate term, the long-term impact detracts from the University's ability to maintain and advance its strategic priorities.

A 2% domestic and 5% international tuition increase is sub-inflationary and does not cover self-funded contractual salary increases for some of our largest employee associations and is therefore not sustainable in the long term.

We believe this approach also keeps UBC's domestic tuition proposal in line with the other five research institutions in BC. It also conforms to the Province's Tuition Limit Policy.

Non-Instructional Fees

Under the provincial government's Tuition Limit Policy, increases to mandatory fees are limited to 2%. The government's policy has been in place since 2005. In line with this policy, increases of 0% to 2% for mandatory fees are recommended to the Board for approval. The President has approved increases of 2% for non-mandatory fees.

Schedule B: Increases to mandatory Administrative Fees

The Administration recommends increases of 0% to 2%, effective May 1, 2023, for mandatory non-instructional fees as indicated on the attached Appendix 2. Board approval is required for increases to mandatory fees.

Schedule C: Increases to Cost Recovery Items

The President has approved up to a 2% increase for non-mandatory cost-recovery fees, effective May 1, 2023, with a 33%-59% increase for document distribution outside of Canada. These fees are listed on the attached Appendix 3 for information and do not require Board approval. All increases reflect an increase in the cost of delivering services and apply to both the UBC Vancouver and Okanagan campuses.

RE: 2023-24 Cost Recovery Fee Items – Schedule C

Your approval of the attached Schedule C, Cost Recovery Fee items, is requested for the 2023/24 academic year. These fees apply to both the Vancouver and Okanagan campuses. This Schedule was revised in November 2003 to set these items at a cost recovery level and have had increases applied annually ever since. They are presented to the Board for information and not for approval because they are not mandatory fees.

All items have been reviewed, and there is one proposed increase over 2%, and ten fee increases up to 2%, as follows:

PROPOSED INCREASE FOR DOCUMENT DISTRIBUTION OUTSIDE OF CANADA

A 33-59% increase to \$42.80 is proposed for document distribution outside of Canada.

The University currently charges a document distribution fee if students choose to receive their parchment or transcript by courier. Students may also choose to pick up their document in person, or receive a PDF transcript, at no additional cost.

In past years, this document distribution fee was distinguished between USA and International courier. However, courier costs are not distinguished between these two categories, and an average courier cost for all documents distributed outside of Canada was used to determine the proposed cost recovery fee.

PROPOSED INCREASES UP TO 2%


A 2% inflationary increase is proposed for the following administrative services (non-mandatory) to reflect an increase in the cost of delivering services:

- Deferred Examination
- Degree Conversion
- Diploma Certification

- Duplicate Income Tax Receipt T2202A
- Faxes
- Parchment Replacement
- Review of Assigned Standing (per course)
- Supplemental Examination
- Transcript
- Document Distribution Canada Courier

Because these are non-mandatory cost recovery items, an extensive consultation was not conducted. The UBC Alma Mater Society (AMS), Graduate Student Society (GSS), and UBC Students' Union Okanagan (UBCSUO) were informed of these recommended changes on October 3, 2022 and were given an opportunity to provide feedback. The increases, if approved, will be made effective May 1, 2023. Schedule C will be sent to the Board of Governors as an information item.

PREFACE


- As a proudly public university serving the Province of British Columbia, UBC continues to enshrine
 affordability and accessibility for domestic students as key goals and principles. Across our Canadian
 peers, UBC is the second largest provider of student financial aid as a percentage of tuition revenue.
- With steadily growing student financial aid, we have been able to support an increasing number of students each year, while debt levels at graduation have remained relatively constant.
- UBC is also one of the world's top 40 research universities, and our rise in the rankings has allowed
 us to recruit an increasingly competitive domestic and international pool of students, it has allowed us
 to attract many of the world's leading researchers and teachers, and it has resulted in increased
 philanthropic donations, research partnerships, and funding.
- Maintaining our excellence, reputation, and ranking is an investment in our students' futures, ensuring that wherever they go in the world, their UBC degree will be valued passports to opportunities.
- We are committed therefore to ensuring both affordability and accessibility for our students and an
 excellent research, teaching, and working environment for our entire community.

A YEAR OF EXCEPTIONAL FINANCIAL PRESSURES

- Economic recovery, supply chain disruptions, the climate crisis, and the Russian invasion of Ukraine have combined to boost prices sharply in the last year
- For this current year, the Federal and Provincial CPI saw the largest year-over-year increase in nearly 40 years (more than 7%). The HEPI, a measure of inflation across US colleges and universities, is predicting a 5.2% increase for this year



Salaries, supplies and materials, food, construction costs, and utilities were all major contributors to these increases.

UBC BUDGET CONTEXT

• For FY21/22, UBC reported a consolidated net income of approximately **\$161M**. This was driven largely by non-operating accounting gains within the endowment and by internal transfers. Non-operating surplus is restricted in use and cannot be used generally by UBC to pay for salaries and other expenses. **The true operating surplus is approximately \$1M**.



- Roughly one-third of the operating budget is funded by the Provincial grant, with the requirement to teach a minimum number of domestic student FTEs at a tuition rate that is limited to a 2% annual increase. In comparison, the Higher Education Price Index (HEPI) is forecast to increase by 5.2% for calendar 2022.
- For FY20/21 through FY22/23, the operating funding for UBCV Administrative Units was reduced by 1%/2%/2% respectively to manage the financial impact of COVID-19. These cuts will continue through FY23/24 (dropping to 1%) and will be re-evaluated after that period.
- The Administration has invested to create greater efficiencies throughout the various portfolios and to enhance future revenues. We are also drawing down reserves to advance our academic mission, maintain our physical plant, sustain student services, and to sustain investments in key priorities.




COMPARISONS WITH PEER INSTITUTIONS: BENCHMARKING TUITION & STUDENT FINANCIAL AID

BENCHMARKING

- UBC regularly conducts a tuition benchmarking exercise using a Board of Governors approved methodology. For the prior and current year, UBC also benchmarked the amount of student financial aid as a percentage of tuition revenue.
- The benchmarked peer institutions include several members of the U15 Group of Canadian Research
 Universities (University of Toronto, McGill University, McMaster University), members of the Research
 Universities' Council of British Columbia, Kwantlen Polytechnic University, Douglas College and Langara
 University.
- UBC strives to maintain a reasonable relationship between tuition and rankings with our leading Canadian
 peer postsecondary institutions for international students. We are restricted to 2% increases for domestic
 student tuition, and this restriction reproduces —and each year increases— initial differences in domestic
 tuition with our BC sister institutions that are unrelated to rankings or excellence.

Annual domestic tuition at select U15 research universities: BA & BSc Programs (2022/23 academic year)





Annual domestic tuition at select BC institutions: BA & BSc Programs (2022/23 academic year)





Annual international tuition at U15 research universities: BA & BSc Programs (2022/23 academic year)



Annual international tuition at select BC institutions: BA & BSc Programs (2022/23 academic year)







FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR UBC STUDENTS

- In 2021/22, \$392.8M in total student financial support was provided to UBC full-time students, a \$455K or 0.1% increase from the previous year. Of this amount, \$258.8M is non-repayable and \$134M is in the form of Canada and US repayable loans.
- The total amount of domestic tuition fees net of financial aid provided to students has been relatively steady since 2017, while student financial support in comparison continues to grow year over year



DOMESTIC STUDENT TUITION VS STUDENT FINANCIAL SUPPORT

- In FY21/22, **\$390M** was collected in domestic student tuition and fees. In the same year **\$392.8M** in total student financial support was provided to full-time students **(\$131M** from the operating budget).
- 47% of full-time domestic students (34,034 out of 72,281 students across both campuses) received received financial assistance in 2021/22 (non-repayable & repayable).



- Of the 34,034 students receiving awards, 24,875 (73%) were domestic and 9,193 (27%) international.
- For students receiving financial aid, annual increases in tuition will be funded by increases in financial support.



DOMESTIC STUDENT DEBT AT UBC

- The number of unique full-time students supported by Student Financial Assistance has increased by 22% over the past five years, with students receiving UBC funding* accounting for the majority of the increase. Over the same period, the number of domestic full-time students supported by Student Financial Assistance has increased by 11% and the overall number of domestic students has increased by 1%.
- For FY21/22, UBC provided \$6.3M in one-time housing support to 2,971 students from low-income families through the UBC General Bursary Program.



Graduate Outcomes Survey of 2019 UBC graduates, the median government student debt amount incurred** was \$30K of which \$25K remained outstanding two years out (16% of cohort was international). Of note, there is a 6-month non-repayment period following graduation when interest does not accrue and an income contingent plan.



- In FY21/22, of the 52,868 domestic undergraduate and graduate students enrolled at UBC, 14,444 (27%) full-time domestic students received funding support from the Canada Student Loans Program, a 4% increase over the prior year. A total of \$201.9M was disbursed to these 14,444 students, a 9% decrease over the prior year. The non-repayable portion of this \$201.9M amounts to 30.5%, slightly higher than the 26.5% of the prior year.
- UBC's repayment rate is 95.1% (2020), exceeding the national threshold of 85.2%.

TUITION PROPOSAL AND IMPACT



TUITION PROPOSAL

The Administration proposes the following tuition increases:

- 5% tuition increase for all new international undergraduate students and international graduate students in programs with specialized rates,
- 3% tuition increase for similar international continuing students, and
- 2% increase for all new and continuing domestic students and international graduate students in
 research and standard programs. This 2% increase also applies to all mandatory fees. The estimated
 incremental tuition revenue of \$27.6M and its distribution is included in the table below.

IMPACT ON OUR STUDENTS

- A 2% increase will cost domestic students roughly \$114; a 5% increase will result in roughly \$1,200 additional costs for international students (in high-tuition programs, this could be as high as \$3,900). Significant financial support will be available to ensure each student can maintain a reasonable standard of living.
- This approach keeps UBC's domestic tuition increases in line with those of the other five research institutions in BC, and it conforms to the Province's Tuition Limit Policy.

BENEFITS FLOWING FROM THE TUITION PROPOSAL



With the proposed tuition increases and with ongoing central budget cuts, we will be able to invest in the following areas:

- Implementing key university strategic priorities, including the recommendations from the Student Affordability Task Force, the President's Task Force on Anti-Racism and Inclusive Excellence Report, the Indigenous Strategic Plan*, the UBC Climate Action Plan/UBC's response to the Climate Emergency, and faculty renewal through the PAEI.
- An outstanding student experience, inclusive of funding for in-classroom and Post-Covid on-line learning, informal learning space improvements, and experiential education
- Provide funding to support the health and wellbeing of our students, faculty and staff
- Support international students with visas, study permits, work permit applications, health insurance, and transition to Canada
- Offset the impact of inflation on utilities, infrastructure, and self-funded salary progression
- Support the collections of the University Library
- Implement IRP Student and enhance UBC's cybersecurity
- Enhance the professoriate through the PAEI program





- Due to the compounding effect of tuition, if domestic tuition rate increases are not approved,
 we would lose approximately \$69M in revenue over 10 years.
- Such a decrease would cause multi-year difficulties in resourcing student advising, support services, and programs; excellence in teaching and learning; faculty hiring plans; academic capital projects; select core operations.
- A 0% increase would be regressive, favoring students who can most afford our current tuition levels.
- A 0% tuition increase would be impossible to reverse in future years, given the Province's cap on domestic tuition.
- We would see a prolongation of COVID impacts, budgetary stresses, delayed investment in the academic mission, student life, and infrastructure. It would increase the likelihood of additional budget cuts and reductions in staffing.





- The Administration has recently concluded student consultations on this proposal for tuition increases.
- **4,868** respondents completed this year's student tuition consultation, an increase of 70 (1.5% increase) from the FY22/23 consultation.
- The results of this consultation will be reported by the Vice President Students.



DOMESTIC STUDENT DEBT IN CANADA


Assistance has more than doubled over the past 20 years, while repayable student debt hasn't increased since the 1990's

FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR UBC STUDENTS

- In 2021-22, **\$392.8M** in total student financial support was provided to UBC full-time students, a **\$455K** or **0.1**% increase from the previous year. Of this amount, **\$258.8M** is non-repayable and **\$134M** is in the form of Canada and US repayable loans.
- A total of 34,034 UBC full-time students received at least one form of financial assistance, representing 47% of the full-time student population. Compared to the prior year, 2021-22 had a 10% increase YoY in the number of unique students supported.
